

# Chinook at a Glance

Tawny in color from honey to red. Dilute tawny color is acceptable

Darker ears and some dark masking is preferred

Coat is longer over the ruff, shoulders, withers, breeches, and underline

Prominent prosternum extending past point of shoulder

Chest well filled and deep- reaching to elbows

Forelegs are straight with moderate, oval bone

Front feet may turn slightly outward

Inquisitive, friendly expression

Neck blends smoothly into withers. Moderate layback in shoulders

Topline strong and level with slight rise over loin

Thick, double coat lying close to body

Slightly sloping, muscular croup

Well coated, sabre tail with moderate fringing.

Tail set just below level of topline

height to length ration 9 to 10. body should be hard and muscular with moderate bone

Pasterns parallel to each other and perpendicular to ground

Hindquarters muscular and strong with moderate angulation. Well defined thigh muscles



Feet are tight and oval

Ribs are well sprung

Moderate tuck up

Rear dewes must be removed
